## GUIDELINES FOR A SAFE SITE VISIT

1. No on-site parking is available; you may walk to the jobsite trailer from 10<sup>th</sup> Street or you can go to any of the Wishard shuttle stops and ride the shuttle to the tour site. When you board the shuttle let the driver know you are going on a construction site tour so they can take you to the drop off point. **The shuttle will travel its normal route this is not direct to the construction site.**
2. All visitors shall sign a waiver of responsibility and liability in order to make a visit to the construction areas.
3. No visitors will be allowed on site without a designated guide.
4. All visitors must receive an “abbreviated” Orientation prior to proceeding with your guide. The orientation will be given by your PMCM escort at the time of the visit and prior to going on site. Topics shall include the following items in addition to any known hazards or types of work which may introduce hazards to our visitors. Be aware of your surroundings and take extreme caution while on site. Be Safe and Enjoy Your Visit at the New Eskenazi Health. Pay particular attention to:
  - a. Motorized Equipment on site and inside
  - b. Scaffold and workers above you
  - c. Slip, Trip, and Fall Hazards
  - d. Fall Exposures
  - e. Stay clear of power tools
  - f. Always know where the nearest exit to the building and/or site is at all times
  - g. Adhere to all PPE requirements (hard hat, safety glasses, high visibility clothing, long pants, 4 inch sleeves on shirts)
  - h. Crane activity
5. Everyone MUST WEAR safety glasses, high visibility vest, gloves, and a hard hat at all times (items will be provided). If you wear glasses we have side shields to be worn in conjunction with them or other safety glasses that cover your existing glasses.
6. Sunglasses are not to be worn in enclosed or covered areas as they may restrict ones vision.
7. **Boots or leather shoes with hard soles are required; GUEST WEARING TENNIS SHOES, SANDALS, CLOGS, OR OPEN TOED SHOES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO TOUR.**
8. Ladies are encouraged to wear slacks versus dresses.
9. You are to stay with your guide at all times and not wander away from the group.
10. You are encouraged not to touch items while on your tour. Some may recently have been painted or are wet (not cured). Other items may have splinters or unforeseen hazards which could cause injury. It is best to follow the actions of your guide or ask first. Please refrain from running your hand along the perimeter guardrail cable splintering may be present in the cable, which may also cause an injury to occur.
11. In the event an emergency alarm is sounded (air horn), please follow the direction of your guide and do not leave the tour group.
12. Upon completion of your tour, return any safety equipment issued to you.
